## INTRODUCTION

# How to Begin a Community

The first step in building any community is to have a space for living. If you have land + have space for others to gather via RV's, Yurts, Camping, Tiny Homes, Container Homes or Building, then you are half way there! The next step is for the landowner/community builder to establish clear communication on what type of exchange they are seeking. This can include a financial compensation from gatherers, work trade, or exchanging skills/assistance with taking care of the land/gardening/growing/animal care, etc. It is important to have a clear outline of what type of equal energy exchange you are seeking so that all community members are on the same page.



Community members may also choose to financially purchase land together, as a family, group, or co-op rather than gathering on the land of another. This is a great model for those who have established community members, and should communicate what responsibilities are to be shared by the founding members.

## CHAPTER I

# Communal Living Model

## What are the communal living models?

Any 5D community will have some aspect of communal resources. Again, there are no rules for how to create your community, and all are free to establish their own guidelines. Some communities may choose to have an inter-dependence model, while others may choose to have a communal resources mode.

An inter-dependent model is where all community members who either gather on another's land, or choose to purchase/obtain land together as a group, are each responsible for providing resources for their themselves/family.

For example) An inter-dependent community may have each being/pair/family provide financial exchange for living on the land, and they are responsible for supporting themselves financially in terms of their own needs.

In this type of model, there is still communal activities, gatherings, etc., and all community members provide support for one another through sharing + exchanging, but are functioning independently within the community.

Another model of community is to have a communal resources community. This model works best with community members who have an established relationship with one another, and all are providing resources to support + share with the entire community.

For example) In a communal model, you may have a being/family who provides financial resources to pay for living expenses such as electricity, water, internet, etc., for the entire community. You may have another being/family who is able to grow and provide food to share for the community. Similarly, you may have beings or families that are able to provide things such as child care for the community.

In this model, it is important to establish the roles of each being/pair/family within the community, and ensure that all community members are providing equal energy exchange for the whole. These roles can always change or be altered, through discussion and agreement of all community members.

All models of communal living must ensure that all community members are in the heart, with love at their core.

## CHAPTER II

# Living With Simplicity

## The benefits of simplicity

New Earth or 5D Communities will be based on simplicity + synergy. Simple living creates more space for creativity, joy, relaxation and peace.

## How to get started

1. Each community member may feel into what their "needs" are, and cut out anything that is non-essential for their living, joy or comfort.
2. All community members may establish things like community activities, gatherings or community meals. This keeps things simple for all beings within the community.
3. Each being/pair/family should keep their spaces or dwellings clear of any and all clutter. This keeps the energy freely flowing within the community.
4. The land or community space should be kept with minimalism. If the land, space or community becomes cluttered, energy becomes stagnant and begins to effect everyone within the community.
5. Being in tune with nature + incorporating flowers, plants, grow beds within the community keeps everyone in synergy with Mother Earth.



## CHAPTER III

# Right Action + Synergy

**Right Action within Individual Spaces**

Each member of the community is responsible for keeping their space/dwelling in Right Action. Right action means we are doing the correct thing at the correct time. All communities become living organisms. When one aspect of the organism is out of alignment, it brings the entire organism out of alignment. Keeping our spaces clean, in right action, + aligned with love is essential for the health of the community.

**Right Action in Communal Spaces**

Most communities will choose to have communal areas for unity gatherings, events, cooking, bathroom facilities, etc. All members of the community are responsible for keeping these spaces in right action. These can be established roles or switching off of responsibilities. This keeps the entire community in synergy + flow.

**Right Action for Community**

Each community should also create clear roles + responsibilities for Right Action within the community. Taking community garbage out, mowing the land, caring for the plants/gardens, fixing or providing maintenance for community facilities, etc., should be established. This keeps the community in Right Action + all are participating in the care of the community.

# Community Values

## Creating Community Values

It is essential for every community to establish what their values, dreams + visions are. We are all One Humanity, however, we realize and understand that each being is unique and has different ideas of what is most important to them.


In order to create the highest levels of synergy, joy + peace amongst the community, these values must be established early on by either the landowner or the community founders.
